

**PARENT'S RELEASE AND WAIVER OF RIGHT TO SUE OR COLLECT
DAMAGES ON BEHALF OF MINOR
Ohio Revised Code Section 2305.321(C)(2)(a) - Immunity as to equine activity risks

2. Since your child is a participant in an equine activity, you are advised you are releasing and waiving certain rights by allowing your child to participate. You are specifically waiving, releasing and giving up any right to sue or recover damages sustained as a result of the inherent risks of equine activity. You are doing this on behalf of your child, yourself and anyone else who may have the right to sue or recover damages. By your signature below, you are warranting and representing that you have the legal authority to waive these rights on behalf of your child. If you are unsure about whether you have this right, due to divorce, legal custody or guardianship, your child cannot participate until such matter is resolved.

3. If these conditions are not acceptable to you, you may receive a full refund of any money you have paid and decline to participate.

4. Under Ohio Revised Code Section 2305.321, an equine activity sponsor, participant, or equine activity professional is not liable in a civil action for damages, for any of the risks associated with the activity including, but not limited to the following:

(a) The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death or loss to persons on or around the equine (Initial)_____.

(b) The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sudden sounds, movement, unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals (Initial)_____.

(c) Hazards, including, but not limited to surface or subsurface conditions (Initial)_____.

(d) A collision with another equine, animal, a person or an object (Initial)_____.

(e) The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death or loss to the person of the participant or to other persons, including, but not limited to failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant (Initial)_____.

5. A complete copy of this statute has been made available for me to review. I understand I can withdraw my child from this equine activity before I sign this release. I have been advised I may receive a full refund of any money I have paid if these conditions are not acceptable. (Initial)_____.

6. Keeping all of the foregoing risks that are known and any other unknown potential risks in mind, I am freely and voluntarily allowing my child to enter and participate in this equine event. By my signature below, that I am expressly agreeing, on behalf of myself and my child as follows:

A. To release and waive any right to sue and/or collect damages from Terry Anderson, Jacqueline Nadler, Willow Run Ranch LLC, or any of his, hers or its agents, helpers, sponsors or employees for any and all liability for any injury my child might receive or any damage my child might sustain in this equine activity. This shall include, but is not limited to the following:

(a) Damages I or my child might incur for medical bills, lost wages, out-of-pocket expenses, permanent injury or death.

(b) For pain and suffering.

(c) Nominal and/or punitive damages.

(d) Any recovery I might have had for monetary damages, for myself, my child, my heirs, my horse or property.

7. This Release and Waiver is made on behalf of myself, my child, my spouse, if any, my heirs, executors, administrators, subrogates and assigns, or on behalf of any other children, if applicable.

8. I understand that no riding helmets are being provided. I agree to allow my child to assume the risk of riding with or without a helmet. I understand my child may wear a helmet if I choose, or my child chooses. I agree that my child is acting at his/her own risk by participating.

9. I warrant and represent that I have the right to execute this release of behalf of the child in question with full legal authority to bind myself and any other parent.

10. This release is valid until revoked by me in writing.
